



## **Report on the Spring Workshops**

**March 11 - March 31, 2024**

Suruchi Kendra organized "Spring Workshops" for the age groups 4 years and above in different disciplines. For the first time we tried to work with the very young 4 years and above (Balwadi students) and tried to involve them in Theatre activities in the workshop PLAY N ACT. Nearly 25 students participated and presented a short skit for their Parents on the last day "RAJU TOPIWALA" which was thoroughly enjoyed by the Parents. Another group of Balwadi students enrolled themselves for a free style dance workshop STEP IN STYLE. 24 students enrolled and presented a short dance performance for their parents in the Suruchi mini Hall.

FLORAL SYMPHONY was a workshop organized for the ladies who were interested in learning the art of fresh flower arrangement. This workshop was conducted by Smt. Reena Tomar a well experienced person and senior member of Kitchen association of Jaipur. She taught various styles of arrangements like miniature, Ikebana, Central styles.

MOBILE PHOTOGRAPHY WORKSHOP was conducted by Dr. Shweta Shotriya an accomplished wildlife photographer who explained the various aspects of basic photography to the students and provided them with hands on experience in the field using their personal mobiles.

DRAMA TOGETHER This was a theatre workshop which enrolled 65 students from classes 1 to 8. This 15 days workshop provided the students the experience of learning theatre games and exercises to overcome their stage fear, build confidence and camaraderie. In the end a short play was produced highlighting the significance of healthy food over junk food. Another group produced the play "Chamatkari Khamba" The parents of these students were the audience who enjoyed the performance of their wards.

LET'S DRAW & PAINT This 15 days workshop was for the art lovers who love to draw & paint. This time they were taught Landscapes in water color, doodle art & caricaturing. Shri Ankesh Kumar Sharma was the resource person and 48 students participated.

PLAY WITH CLAY & PAPER MACHIE This was a short three days workshop which had 30 participants who enjoyed creating eco- friendly articles with clayey soil. Students gave wings to their imagination and created animals like dog, rabbit and other articles with clayey soil and paper mache.

Nearly 200 students participated in the SPRING WORKSHOPS with great enthusiasm and were happy to spend the break soon after their examination very fruitfully.
