

Summer Camp 2023 at Bhavan's Suruchi Kendra Jaipur

A BREIF REPORT

Bhavan's Suruchi Kendra the cultural centre organized several activities in the Month of May & June 2023 under the banner of Summer camp activities 2023.

A plethora of activities catering to different age groups and different disciplines were planned. All activities were open for any student of that age group.

Nearly 215 students from the age group of 4 to 14 years enthusiastically took part in various activities.

21 students enrolled themselves in the stage anchoring workshop conducted by Ms.Akshini Bhatnagar. These 7 days workshop sensitized the students on different kinds of programs and their anchoring styles.

Workshops like clay modeling, craft work and Paper machie encouraged the students to use their hands and mind to bring out their hidden creativity. The participants carried back home self- created clay models, craft work, wall murals and coasters with Pride.

Lot of emphasis was given to our traditional folk art forms like paper machie & clay modeling.

The art stroke was a 25 days workshop for learning various techniques of drawing & painting like sketching, shading, still life, portrait, water coloring to name a few. 41 students took part. The finale was in the form of an exhibition visited by the parents and the management of Bhavan's Jaipur Kendra .

Another 25 days workshop was in Theatre for which 30 students enrolled. It was a production based workshop which culminated in two short plays. Both the plays were highly appreciated and attended by the Parents and the management members in Bhavan's Suruchi Kendra Mini hall.

Closing ceremony for the art stroke and theatre workshop was organized on June 11, 2023. Chairman of Bhavan's Jaipur Kendra Shri V.C. Surana was the chief guest for the occasion many members of the management were also present and witnessed the exhibition and two plays staged by the theatre students.

Two students from the theatre group were adjudged the best performers and 2 each from the two groups of art students were also given prizes by the chairman.
