

Report on the Summer Camp 2024

A month-long summer camp was organized by Suruchi kendra for the students of the age group 5 to 14 years from May 13 to June 12, 2024.

Various activities were organized in the form of workshops. Experts in the respective fields were engaged as the resource persons. A record 233 students enrolled in nearly 9 different activities.

Theatre activities enrolled 65 students who were further divided into 3 groups. All three groups prepared a short play which was staged on the final day for the Parents and invited guests. Ms. Ayushi Dixit, Shri Panakj Sharma & Shri Arif Khan were the resource persons for the same.

Artistic expressions was a art workshop which involved the students to learn various art techniques like

Dot Painting, Tribal Art, Portrait Making, Charcoal Drawing, Knife Painting, Monochromatic Painting etc.

Shri Ankesh Kumar Sharma & Smt. Divya Arora were the resource persons. The Paintings prepared in this workshop was displayed in an exhibition for the Parents on the final day.

Workshop on contemporary dance was organized as THE DANCE CONNECTION. Nearly 41 students enrolled for the same. They learnt various popular dance steps and prepared two dance performances as finale. To sensitize the students to the nuances of classical dances workshop for the beginners was organized nearly 10 students participated and got exposed to the dance form. Ms. Antima Joshi was the resource person.

Folk art forms like Clay Modeling, Paper Mache, Pottery, Mask Making, Wall Hangings, best out of waste has always attracted the young and the old. Creative crafting workshop was organized for nearly ---students. They enjoyed working with hand and heart and created lot of craft material like their own name plates, wall hangings, clay articles and many more. The work was displayed for the parents as well.

Instrumental music workshops enrolled nearly 34 students. Most of them were beginners and some were our own regular students who made the use of the

long summer vacation to brush up what they were learning. They enrolled for Guitar, Keyboard, Violin and Drums. Some of our regular students gave a performance on the final day.

The Final performance was organized at Maharana Pratap Auditorium on June 13 ,2024. Nearly 300 people witnessed the program and encouraged the participating students.
